

2008 Youth Scholarship Rules

Scholarship Cuttings

All weekends that are included in the Mountain West Saddle Series will also host two youth scholarship cuttings. Payout in the scholarship cuttings shall be \$400 for 1st Place in both the senior and junior youth; \$300 for second in both the senior and junior youth; and, \$200 for 3rd in the both the senior and junior youth. In order to determine the number of places in each class to receive scholarships, the following payout format will be used. There must be three riders to make a class.

1-2 entries	1 scholarship - \$200
3 entries	1 scholarship - \$400
4-5 entries	2 scholarships - \$400, \$300
6 & up entries	3 scholarships - \$400, \$300, \$200

If there is not enough to make separate youth classes, a combined youth class will be formed and scholarship money will be paid out to junior and senior again according to the above format. For example: if there are two junior youth and three senior youth, a combined class will be held with five youth. There will be one scholarship paid in the junior - \$200 (2 entries) and one scholarship paid in the senior - \$400 (3 entries).

Scholarships must be claimed within two years of getting out of the youth. A recipient may ask for one time extension of two years.
